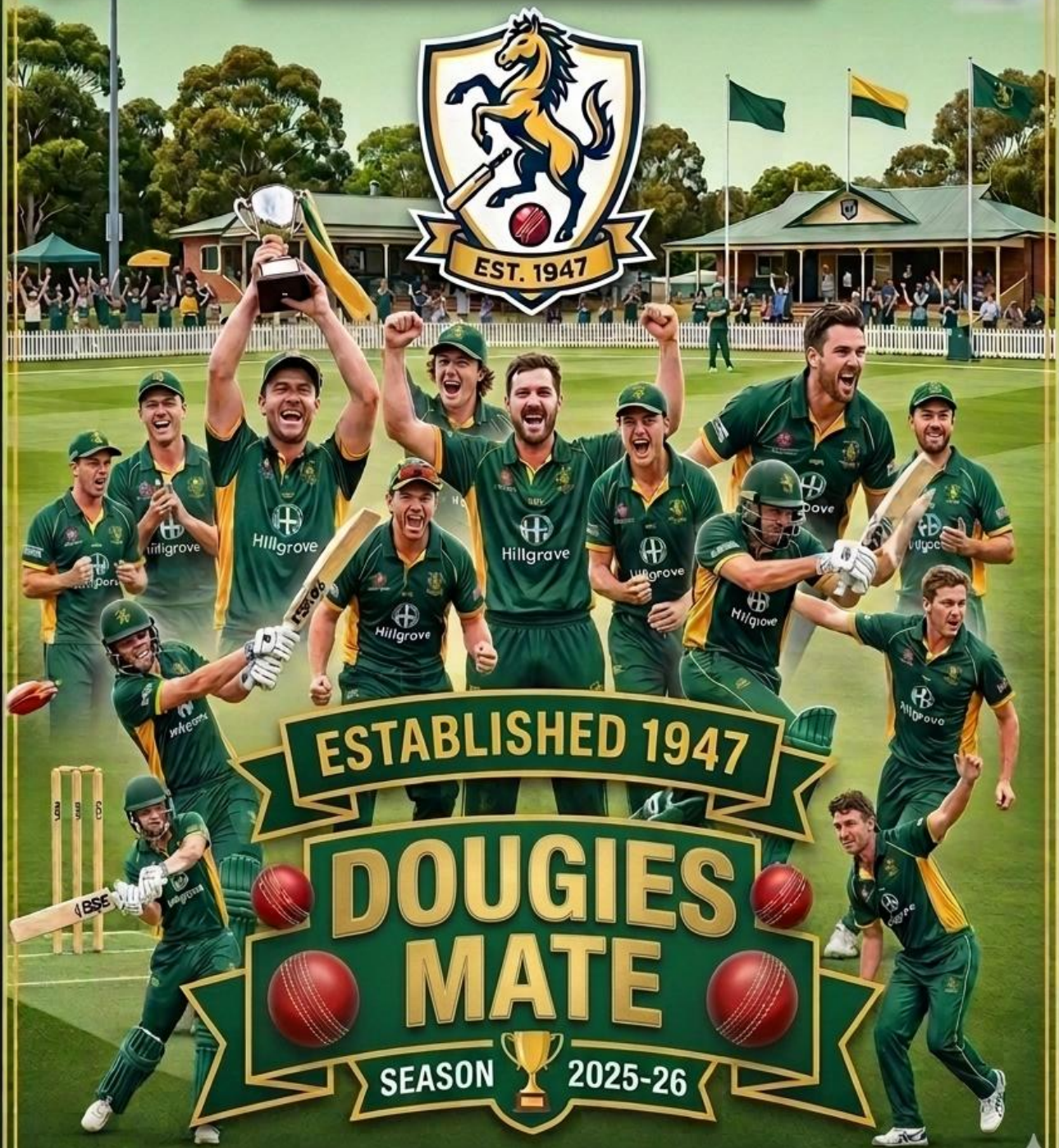

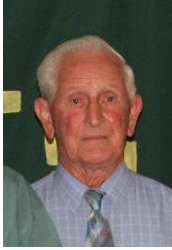

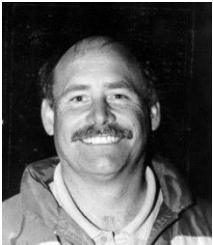

Peter Hickey Memorial Trophy



The Peter Hickey Memorial Trophy for the player **most likely to succeed**, is in memory of the late Peter Hickey who played 1st grade for the club for approximately 10 years during the late 1970's to the late 1980's. He was an exceptionally talented bowler, and had been on a world tour with the Northern NSW Emu's Cricket club in 1974. The trophy was donated by his family after his untimely death in 1991.



The Royal Hotel Trophy - Clubman of the year



The Royal Hotel trophy for clubman of the year would've been donated by Joe Barbato the owner and publican of the Royal hotel. They were our club sponsors for approximately 10yrs in the late 80's early 90's. Joe himself never actually played cricket for Hillgrove, however his son Peter played in the lower grades for the grove.



Tom Dye Memorial Trophy - Player of the Year

The Tom Dye Memorial Trophy for the Player of the Year is in memory of the late Tom Dye who was one of the club's early players during the 50's. Tom was a wicketkeeper and up until his passing he was a patron and a very keen supporter of Hillgrove Colts Cricket Club.

2025-26 First Grade

This season was made up of 14 x 1-day round matches and 6 x T20 matches

We fared quite well in the 1-day rounds, winning 9 of them, 3 no results due to washouts, and 2 losses, both to TAS. This saw us finish Minor Premiers and advance straight through to the GF

The T20 rounds weren't so kind to us, only winning the 1 game, 1 no result, and 4 losses. We did have a lot of players who were unavailable due to other commitments during this time; however, we didn't really adapt very well to this format and were bowled out inside the 20 overs way too often

As in past seasons, we used 24 players throughout the year but this is indicative of the fact that there are a lot of other things going on in people's lives. A positive note was that we never had to play short. This is mostly due to the hard work of the selection committee, so thank you to you guys!

Ben Heagney had a great year with the bat, scoring over 400 runs and our leading run scorer. He more often than not got us off to a great start with the bat. Unfortunately, he was often a lone hand and we didn't capitalise at times. He made his maiden 1st grade century this season. The first of many I hope. He was also great in the field too

Grant Ryan was a little bit lean in the runs department this season. He always gives 100% in whatever he is doing. His knowledge of the game is incredible, and he always passes on his thoughts to me when needed

David Schmude was missing earlier in the year but returned to the top order and was as aggressive as always with his batting. He also took some fantastic catches

Lucas Kiel- didn't quite have the season with the bat this year that he did the year before, but was always handy to score some runs. Particularly liked bullying the TAS kids around at TAS. He bowled some handy overs of both medium pace and off spin too. Gun in the field and always the 1st to training.

Ian Ranger in his 1st full season with the club. Was rusty with the gloves in the 1st couple of games but didn't he turn it on in the last few weeks. Great leg side catching and a sensational season with the gloves overall. He also put together some nice innings with the bat. Typical wicketkeeper with his entertaining banter

Cotter Litchfield has had a phenomenal year leading the way with both bat and ball; he is really maturing as a cricketer now. Almost 200 runs and 24 wickets in the 40-over format. Safe hands in the field too.

Fraser Berry (Chuck) was playing park cricket in Sydney last season and has come to Armidale following his girlfriend so that she can pursue her career in childcare. Slotted in at number 4 and has batted quite well at times. Has proven to be very handy with his slow off-spin bowling too. Will be even better next season

Hamish Biddle always seems to come good at the end of the season. He has been a model of consistency with the ball and has even found some form with the bat. He had a high score of 40 off the bat this season. This may be his last year with the Grove as he moves on to bigger and better things. I wish him all the best.

Ryan Harris- brought up a milestone this season that I am sure he would want to forget; however, he was our 2nd leading wicket taker for the season. He rarely went for many runs off the bat, and we definitely missed him in the GF. He also hit some important runs at the end of matches

Mitch Woods is like a fine bottle of red- he just gets better with age. Fantastic guy to have bowling and is more than handy with the bat too. He prides himself on his fielding, also. Mitch played for Australia in the Over 55s tour of South Africa. We definitely missed him in the Grand Final too.

Darcy Cassidy, this guy turned up to training one day as he had just finished school at Farrer. He was a bit like a baby giraffe at first, all arms and legs. He put in the hard yards at every training session and fought his way into a 1st grade position at the end of the season. He bowled some great spells and will only improve as we move into next season. He showed his nerve with the bat a few times with some very important red inks.

Haydon Freeman, following in his father's footsteps to play at the Grove. He played some valuable innings and bowled some important overs too. I don't think I've seen a faster fielder across the ground either. Floated a little bit between 1sts and 2nds this season

2025-26 Second Grade



As returning Skipper of Hillgrove Second Grade this season, I'm very proud of the cricket we played. A great bunch of blokes playing in the true spirit of the game.

The Second Grade competition was probably as strong as we have seen for some years with the two Easts sides and Walcha/Uralla both very strong, City also capable and Armidale United probably finding themselves a grade too high, floundering.

Although we had some close games, we didn't win a 40 over game before Christmas. It didn't help that we started with a narrow loss to City, then played Easts three times in a row... We actually didn't play a game against United in the entire 40 over competition and it took until the end of January to play Walcha/Uralla - which we won!

A comprehensive loss to Easts followed and it was feeling like our season was done. Guess who we played the following week? Yes, Easts again, but this time we came up trumps, defeating them inside 32 overs.

Needing everything to go our way from here to make finals, a forfeit win against United, a win against City and a controversial "Custom target score" win against Walcha/Uralla saw Hillgrove sneak into third place to play Easts Yellow in the final.

Batting first, our opening combination of D Moffitt and I Galpathage was solid. It's worth noting that the form of these two contributed greatly to our success late in the season. Dave's last three innings were 95, 96 not out and 29. Ish supporting with 22, 28 and 48. R Eastwood batting at three scored 48 in the final and we scrambled to 179 after losing some quick wickets.

Opening bowlers A Curry and L Eastwood were very economical, and tidy spells from J Tomes, A Dullaway and T Chapman followed, but wickets were hard to come by. We took the game a lot deeper than it felt at the time and Easts passed our score in the 38th over.

Player availability plagued us throughout the season, especially either side of Christmas when the T20 competition was played and we used 33 players before the season was finished. Max Laurie deserves a special mention here as he worked tirelessly, in his roll as Chair of Selectors, to fill all teams each week.

Player availability aside, we shone in the T20 competition, winning our first three games and doing enough to make it into the Grand Final played on Australia Day against United. This United side played in the first grade 40 over competition but dropped back to seconds for the T20's. They were unbeaten, and had defeated us the week before the grand final. We knew we needed to be on our game when we played them again.

Losing the toss, we were sent in on a sound deck. T Chapman and D Moffitt made a good start before both getting out on 25. This brought R Eastwood to the crease. He batted with great intent yet balanced risk and aggression to score 59 not out from 46 putting us in a commanding position. H Freeman 33 from 28 and D Waters 14 not out off 7 gave us a total of 4- 144.

It was a solid team performance in the field with catches taken and economic bowling from all, especially T Chapman. 1 for 15 off 4. T Chapman, J Tomes and H Freeman all took a wicket in their first over, putting the pressure right back on United. With the required run rate getting out of control, United fell 25 runs short of the target. Soo the Grove! Silverware for us and the title of T20 CHAMPIONS!

Congratulations to First and Third Grades on their successful seasons. Also, a big thank you to Brad & Al for providing game summaries to be included in the weekly Facebook 'Around the Grounds' report.

Finally, thank you to all 33 players, their families and supporters that shared their Saturday afternoons with me this season. I greatly appreciate it and have thoroughly enjoyed it all. I very much look forward to next season.
